

Privacy Policy

Our company provides you with this privacy policy ("Privacy Policy") to let you know our information collection and usage policies and practices that apply to information collected on our website at www.pareinc.com (the "Site"). By using the Site, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy and agree to be bound by the Site's Terms of Use. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy or the Terms of Use, you should discontinue your use of the Site.

Information Collection

When you visit the Site, our company collects information about you and your browsing habits. The information we collect depends on the pages of our website you visit and what you do during your visit.

Our company may collect information from you automatically when you visit our website, which may include the name of the domain and host from which you access the Internet; the Internet protocol (IP) address of your computer; the type of browser and software operating system you use; web log data, including the date and time you access our website; and the Internet address of the website from which you linked to our site.

Our company may also use "message format" and "message open" sensing technologies to enable our company to recognize whether you have enabled your email program to receive HTML emails. If so, this information is associated with your email address so that we can send subsequent messages to you in HTML format. The "message open" sensing technology allows us to recognize whether you have opened our email messages. We can only detect this if you have enabled your email program to receive HTML emails.

For most of the browsing services on the Site, our company does not require your personal information. There are portions of the Site where you will be given the option to provide information about you. The information that you may be asked to provide may include your name, email address, telephone number and address. Depending on your request and other circumstances, other information may also be collected. It is your discretion and determination whether to provide such information. Further, our company may disclose information provided by you as part of any merger, sale, acquisition, or other acquisition of same or all of our company or its assets.
